Musical Festival—Worked out great. \$2170 in donations were raised on Saturday, \$550 in donations were raised Friday evening. The food cost was \$600. With the sponsorship of \$7000 and after expenses, we made \$8000 profit. We may increase sponsorship from \$500 to \$750 next year and by next year we may be building a stage. A neighbor was concerned about parking and blocking emergency access to her home. We will be aware of that for next year.
