

# PRIVACY POLICY

Bill's Creek Community Center recognizes the public's concern about privacy on the Internet. This privacy statement establishes how information gathered about you from your visit to our website will be used by this website's operators. As a visitor, however, you should be aware that much information submitted to BCCC is public information under the laws of the State of North Carolina.

The following describes how information may be collected depending on your activities at this website.

## **If you read or download information:**

We may collect and store information for statistical purposes. For example, we may count the number of visitors to the different sections of our site to help us make them more useful. The information collected may include such items as the name and domain of the host from which you access the Internet, the Internet Protocol (IP) address of the computer you are using, or your browser software and operating system. This information does not identify you personally.

## **If you send an E-mail or register on this website:**

By sending us an electronic mail message or book an event, you will be sending us personal information (i.e., your name, address, e-mail address, etc.). We may store the name and address of the requester in order to respond to the request or otherwise resolve the subject matter of your e-mail. Board members and BCCC volunteers may have access to your personal information to assist in the reservation and confirmation process.

Other information may be collected through questionnaires, feedback forms, or other means to enable us to determine a visitor's interests, with the goal of providing better service.

We do not disclose, give, sell, or transfer any personal information about our visitors or renters, unless required for law enforcement or statute. The email is subject to the North Carolina Public Records Law
