The meeting was called to order at 6:34 6m

Continuing Business

Diane Johnson has been ably manning the medical closet as Julia is on vacation. 3 ice machines for post knee and hip surgery have been added to the rental closet.

The Rainbow Bridge from the Green space in Lake Lure by the firehouse will be moved to the Bills Creek dog park outside the fence likely next week. An area has been prepared with a tarp and gravel by Clif Swan. Chuck will assist in getting 4 or 5 men to assist in the move when there is a definite date and time and the Town will be notified when the move has taken place.

Scholarship – There have been 3 applications submitted thus far from the 28746 area and the applications have been opened to anyone doing service work in that zip code from Rutherford County. A reminder about the offered scholarships will be put out on the 15 th of June with the due date by July 1 st .

Addition- Plans for the addition will be completed by the engineer in the next week and ready to be stamped and permitted hopefully very

soon. Chuck stated that we should be hearing about the possible Grant money very soon also.

BCCC is the next project for the Foundation putting in the solar panels and that should begin later this month.

About 54 people have purchased tickets for the Josh GoForth concert and food on July 16 th . Chuck has been advertising the concert on Facebook and has posted several reminders on local sites.
