- Minutes were read.

TREASURER'S REPORT

- The treasurer's report was read. May 1st balance was \$14,808.99. Income: Donations + AED donations. Expenses: Dog park donation signs, fence repair, rental deposit return, electric bill. The ending balance was \$16,689.53.

PROJECTS

- **Building:** Critters are back, even with rat poison under the building. Hunt Pest Control took care of holes, replaced vents, and will conduct an annual spray. Most renters have been considerate in cleaning, other than one group, but it is important we keep the building and grounds free of trash and leftover food to keep critters away in the first place.
- **Dog Park:** The fence was repaired, the main gate was fixed, the bleachers were disassembled/burned/metal ready for scrap, and the committee is addressing the split for large and small dogs.
- **Community Events:** We are exploring different community event ideas including classes, movie nights (a large screen will be donated), and hosting a breakfast with the Fire dept.
- **AED:** Phil Davis submitted a lengthy document on considerations and recommendations for AED(s). We will continue to collect donations, and address the purchase and location of this life-saving device soon.
- **EXIT Sign:** A lighted emergency Exit sign will be installed at the back door.
- **Raffle:** A 55" TV has been donated for an upcoming raffle – like the 50/50 and TV raffle held at last year's Music Day.

- **Tai Chi:** In an effort to offer affordable community classes, we start a Tai Chi class on Tuesdays at 10 am, starting June 20th. The cost to participants is \$7 per class, of which \$2 will be donated to BCCC. No equipment or experience is required.
