BCCC Meet & Greet Event

Meeting called to order at 6:05pm

MINUTES

- Minutes of the last meeting were not read, but Chuck will present an update of current activities and discussions.

TREASURER'S REPORT

- Our current balance as of August 1st after expenses, cookbook sales and a donation: \$3445.10. A major expense coming up will be the repair of the HVAC system.
- We've started a GoFundMe campaign for donations. The link can be found on the Facebook page. \$1200 of our \$20,000 goal has been raised.
- Donations are greatly appreciated, and can be made via the DONATE box, Facebook page and website.

PAST NEWS

- **Rentals:** The majority of our income comes from Clubhouse rentals. The fees are \$200 for weddings and \$125 for events. A \$50 deposit is required. If the Clubhouse is cleaned, the deposit will be returned. If not, a cleaning crew will be hired.
- **Volunteers:** We need volunteers, especially for the Thanksgiving Turkey Dinner, which will be held this year after a 2-year hiatus. This event generates a significant amount of money for the BCCC.
- **Community:** What defines Bill's Creek Community? There are no real geographic boundaries, so we include everyone in the area and encourage them to participate in the BCCC.

BCCC UPDATE

- The clubhouse is open to the community for events – family, church, and social.

- **Special guest:** The Board meets every 2nd Tuesday of the month. On September 13th County Commissioner Alan Toney will be our guest. He is responsible for county funding, cell service, emergency response time, and other services that are critical to our community. A good showing of attendants is important!
- **Family Fun Day:** Join us for a fun event on October 15th, from 12 noon to 4 pm. We'll have games for children, food for sale and a music jam by Michael Yelton, Tyler Dalton, and others.
- **Thanksgiving Dinner:** This is an important event in our fundraising efforts. We sell Turkey dinners as well as provide/deliver for those in need. This is a collaborative effort with the Bill's Creek Volunteer Fire Department, who holds their annual fundraising raffle – giving away lots of valuable prizes.

QUESTIONS

1. **Are there any Dues?** No dues, just the opportunity to donate and volunteer. With a diverse economic makeup of our community, we appreciate any assistance given. Event revenues help fund the maintenance and improvement of the building and grounds, but donations and volunteers are needed to help give this property the love and attention it needs.
2. **Do we offer a Care Outreach Committee?** Not yet. We just started, but our Board members live in different areas, and as a group can reach out and identify folks who might need assistance. We will discuss starting a list of volunteers and services we can offer to help those in our community who need our care.
3. **What about the Dog Park?** We now have an unofficial Dog Park in the fenced-in softball field. We need to remind dog owners to pick up after their pets and not leave trash on the field. The fence is unlocked, and signage has been suggested to remind dog owners of their responsibility to keep the area clean – making sure it is safe and enjoyable. We applied for an HVAC grant and can do the same for the Dog Park from the Parks & Recreations Department. We had a volunteer that agreed to clean up when he brings his dog to the field.
